



PAGE ANATOMY AND GLOSSARY OF TERMS

BLEED (GREEN): Anything in the green area will get cut off when printed. A printer cannot print all the way to the edge of any document. To get an image all the way to the edge, you must print beyond that edge. Then once cut, the image will go up to the edge of the page.

INNER MARGIN (BLUE): This blue area will be printed but, it's best to keep any wording or important artwork elements out of this area.

SAFE ZONE (YELLOW): Keep all important info such as art and text within this yellow section.
